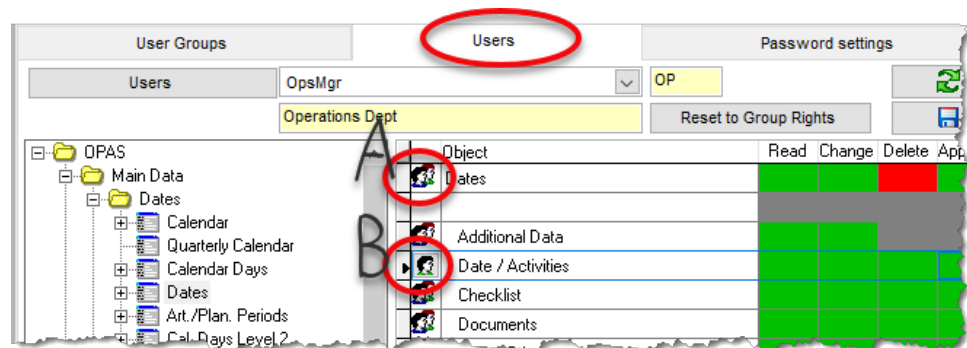




OPAS – Individual / Group Rights

Summary: Individual Users automatically inherit the rights of the Group to which they belong, but those rights can be over-written for the User. A change in the icon tells you whether it's an individual or group right.

User vs. Group right

When setting the rights of an individual user (using the middle, **Users**, tab), this icon tells you whether the permissions in the row are that of the group, or are individual rights that supercede the rights of the group.

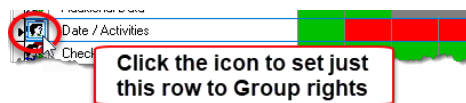


- A.  Rights automatically inherited by the Group
- B.  Individual rights that have been manually set and supercede the Group rights

Re-setting Individual Rights

To reset individual rights...

Click the 'individual' icon on any **row**. This will reset that row to conform to the Users' Group rights.



To undo any individual right settings for the **entire User Account** and re-set it to the Group rights, click the **Reset to Group Rights** button. This restores the individual account to conform exactly with the Group rights in every OPAS program area.
